Oils

Definition: Oil is a concentrated form of typically THC and/or CBD that is extracted from the marijuana plant through various processes that can use solvents and/or heat. Often referred to as Extracts, Concentrates or Hash Oil.

Made with: Marijuana or hemp and sometimes other various ingredients

Intoxication Information: THC oil products do cause cerebral euphoria; especially because of the high THC potency since concentrated. CBD oil products (with zero THC) do not cause cerebral euphoria.

Activation: Immediate to 15 minutes

Forms: Shatter, wax, honeycomb, sap, keif, bubble hash, live resin, distillate and more

Topicals

Definition: THC and/or CBD infused products that are absorbed through the skin.

<u>Made with:</u> Marijuana or hemp and sometimes various essential oils also added

Intoxication Information: Most topicals do not cause cerebral euphoria that comes with other methods of marijuana use because they are not getting into the bloodstream. Transdermal patches & Intimate lubricants however can access the bloodstream which will cause cerebral euphoria.

Activation: Immediate to hours (product depending)

Forms: Lotions, salves, pain sticks, oils, soaking salts, lubricants, sprays, patches and more

Edibles

<u>Definition:</u> THC and/or CBD infused foods & beverages that are ingested.

<u>Made with:</u> Marijuana or hemp and various ingredients

Intoxicating Information: THC infused products do cause the cerebral euphoria because they are getting into the bloodstream once digested or sublingual activation takes place. CBD infused products (with zero THC) do not cause cerebral euphoria.

Activation: 15 minutes to hours (product depending)

Forms: Gummies, chocolates, baked goods, beverages, syrups, mints and more

Terms & Definitions

- THC: Tetrahydrocannabinol is the cannabinoid in marijuana that causes the "high" feeling
- <u>CBD</u>: Cannabidiol is the cannabinoid in marijuana that does not cause the "high" feeling
- <u>Cerebral Euphoria</u>: The feeling of being "stoned" or "high"

Flower

<u>**Definition:**</u> Flower is the smokable part of the marijuana plant, often referred to as buds or nugs.

Made With: Marijuana

Intoxicating Information: Majority of flower products do cause cerebral euphoria because it contains THC. However, some flower strains can have higher levels of CBD and low levels of THC, this combination could potentially not cause euphoria.

Activation: Immediate to 15 minutes

Forms: Loose Flower, shake, joints, decarboxylated flower and more
